CALL FOR PAPERS: 41st Conference of the Italian Association of Labour Economics

Roma Tre University, 17-19 September 2026

The Italian Association of Labour Economics (AIEL), the Department of Political Sciences and the Department of Law of Roma Tre University are pleased to invite submissions for the **41st AIEL Conference**, to be held in **Rome, 17-19 September 2026**. The programme will include invited lectures and parallel sessions. The conference will provide an opportunity to discuss issues related to labour economics and to develop research collaborations. The official language of the conference will be English.

Keynote Lectures

The keynote speakers will be **Katrine Løken** (Norwegian School of Economics) and **Giovanni Peri** (UC Davis).

Co-Organized Parallel Sessions

There will be parallel sessions organized in collaboration with the **Italian Social Security Institute** (INPS) and the **Competence Centre on Microeconomic Evaluation** (CC-ME), **Joint Research Centre** (JRC) of the European Commission.

In particular, the session co-organized with the JRC-CCME will take the form of an open thematic session focused on the evaluation of European Union policies or of policies of clear EU relevance. Scholars interested in presenting their work in this session should submit their paper through the standard submission procedure, selecting the topic "JRC-CCME".

Scholars interested in proposing the organization of parallel sessions are invited to contact the AIEL secretariat before the submission deadline.

AIEL Prizes

All conference papers will be considered for the *Ezio Tarantelli Prize* for the best paper. Papers authored by young scholars will also be eligible for the *Carlo Dell'Aringa Young Labour Economist Prize*, which includes a €1,000 award.

Submissions

Authors should submit their full draft papers via the [AIEL webpage](#). The submission deadline is **15 April 2026**. Acceptance decisions will be notified by **15 May 2026**.
